- The "bLU cRU" logo must be prominently displayed on the upper chest area of the rider's suit to be eligible.
- Contingency models include 2022 and newer YZF-R1, YZF-R7, YZF-R6, YZF-R3, MT-07, MT-09, TT-R110 and TTR-125 models purchased in the United States are eligible.
- YZF-R3's, R6's, R7's and R1's must maintain standard bodywork
- YZF-R6's will be eligible for contingency in 600cc classes only, not in Open classes.
- There must be a minimum of 7 riders in a class to be eligible for contingency.
